



**SOUTH AFRICAN EMBASSY

APPLICATION FOR SOUTH AFRICAN CHILD PASSPORT

Issued to South African citizens under the age of 16 (sixteen) years for a maximum period of 5 (five) years. It is valid for all countries unless otherwise endorsed on page 31. This is a non-renewable document: once expired, the holder must apply for a new passport. Applicants under the age of 16 (sixteen) need not submit fingerprints.

All applicants must produce written consent of either their parents or their guardians, as the case may be, before they may be granted passports. The required written consent by parents must be given in the prescribed space provided for on application BI-73. Both parents are required at the embassy together with the child to submit the application.

All relevant documents must be completed using a BLACK INK PEN

- 3 recent, identical, coloured passport photos,
- Original unabridged birth certificate and a copy,
- Original passport, and a copy,
- Copies of parents' passports,
- Copy of parents' marriage certificate/divorce decree,
- Form BI-529 completed with child as the applicant/reference person
- Form BI-529 completed with each parent as the applicant/reference person,
- Proof of payment –NOK 450 paid to the embassy account: Account Number: 1503 15 38189.
- Form BI-73 to be completed for each child (provided at the embassy)
- If the passport to be replaced has been lost or stolen: police report to that effect.
- Payment of the prescribed fee to the embassy's account : **A/C Number 1503 15 38189**
